



## **Universität Hamburg – Faculty of Business Administration (Hamburg Business School HBS)**

### **Publication of Dissertations as part of the doctoral procedure**

(as per 6 September 2018)

Doctoral students are obligated to make their dissertation accessible to the scientific public in an adequate manner. To fulfill this, please observe the following **deadlines**:

- The dissertation has to be published within 12 months after completion of the doctorate, i. e. after the oral defense. As soon as the dissertation is published, the doctoral student receives a written confirmation such from the State and University Library Hamburg (further on “SUB”).
- According to the Doctoral Degree Regulations 2010 and 2014, the chairperson of the doctoral committee can extend this deadline by another 12 months upon an adequate reasoned request. If the doctoral candidate does not provide such receipt of publication from the library at the faculty’s administration office for doctoral studies within this period the library will publish the dissertation electronically via internet.
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These are the various possibilities to publish the dissertation at HBS (Hamburg Business School = faculty of business administration):
