Universität Hamburg invites applications for a Research Associate in accordance with Section 28 subsection 1 of the Hamburg Higher Education Act (Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz, HmbHG). The position commences on April 1, 2018.

It is remunerated at the salary level TV-L 13 and calls for 50% of standard work hours per week.*

The fixed-term nature of this contract is based upon Section 2 of the Academic Fixed-Term Labor Contract Act (Wissenschaftszeitvertragsgesetz, WissZeitVG). The initial fixed term is three years.

The University aims to increase the number of women in research and teaching and explicitly encourages qualified women to apply. Equally qualified female applicants will receive preference in accordance with the Hamburg Equality Act (Hamburgisches Gleichstellungsgesetz, HmbGleiG).

Responsibilities:

Associates will be expected primarily to conduct research and teach. The associate will have the opportunity to pursue further academic qualifications, in particular a doctoral dissertation. At least one-third of set working hours will be made available for the associate's own academic work.

Specific Duties:

The task area contains support in research, teaching and student evaluation within all fields of information systems. The number of obligatory teaching hours p/w amounts to 2 for a 50% position. The phd thesis can be written within the subject field of computational logistics and can be handed in either in German or in English (preferred). We are also looking for international applicants; however, it is of utmost importance that lectures and courses can be held in German. Additionally, there is an option to turn this position to a full one for a time period from the start at least until December 31, 2018. The full position status cannot be guaranteed after this date. From January 01, 2019 this position is initially guaranteed to be only a part-time position (50%).

Requirements:

A university degree in a relevant field. The studied degree should be completed within the fields of information systems, or a study field with focus on information systems (business administration, business mathematics, business engineering or mathematics). Excellent German and English skills are of utmost importance.



Severely disabled applicants will receive preference over equally qualified non-disabled applicants.
