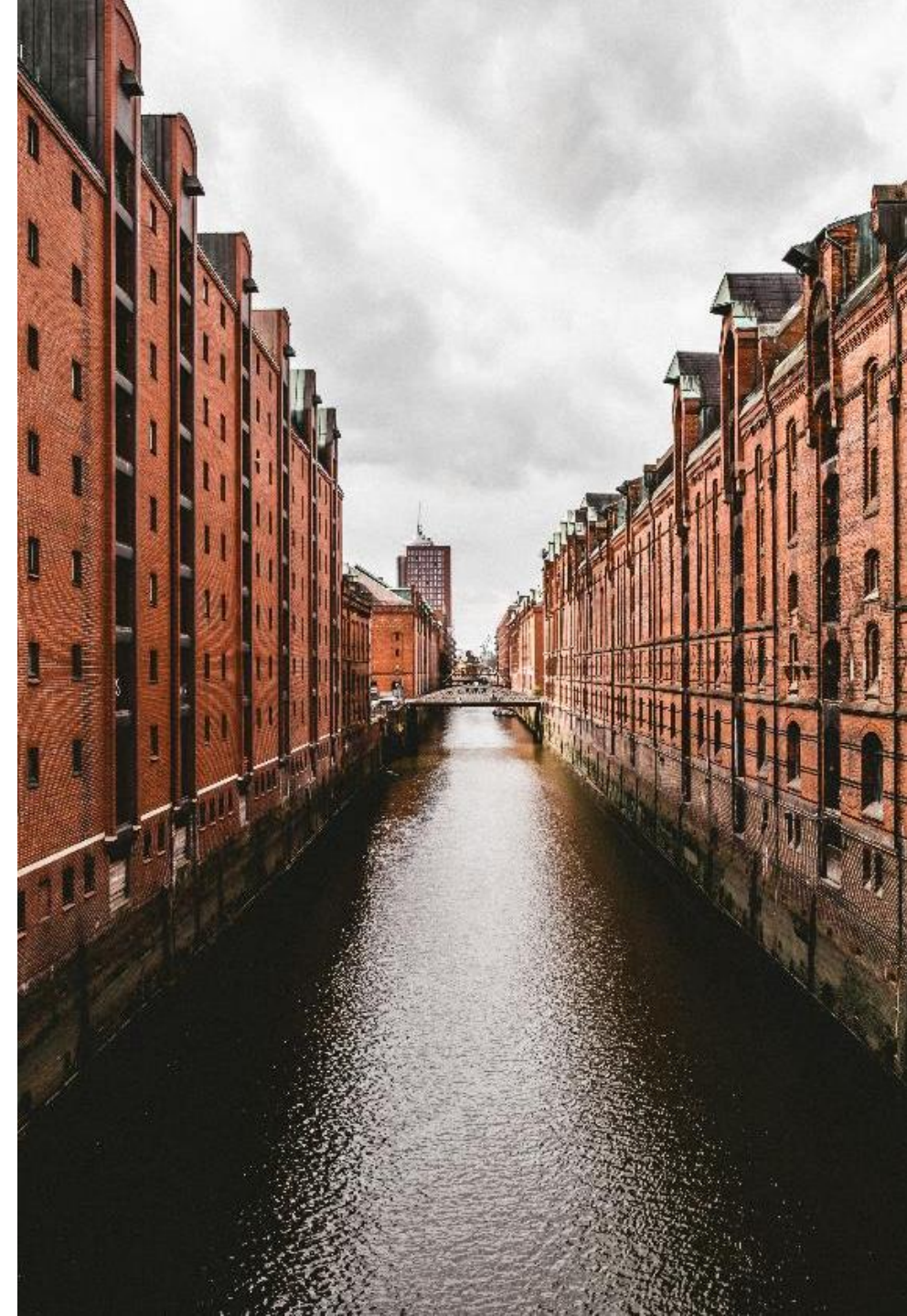


Mission

Selection of specializations

- Students must choose their specialization or specializations right at the beginning of their studies – before registering for their first courses!
- The purpose of today's presentation of all specializations is to help you make your choice within the first few days of your studies.

Combination of specializations

- Generally, there is no temporal overlap between specializations.
- The exceptions are **WPSTEU** and **MIG** as well as **MAN** and **BA**, which share the same time slot and **should not be selected together** if possible.

Time Slot Model (2)

- Time slots have been defined to ensure that there is little overlap between courses in all areas.
- Each time slot accommodates enough modules to obtain the necessary ECTS credits in the respective specialization over three semesters.
- Additional courses in one specialization as well as practical courses may be offered outside the outlined time slots.

Methods Component

- Modules covering methodological, statistical and analytical content
- Offer of required elective modules as specified in the module handbook
- Module code: BWL-MA-METH XY
- Scope: 18 ECTS. A maximum of 12 ECTS can be credited from specializations modules.

Methods – Credits from specializations (max. 12 ECTS)

- BWL-MA-BA 1(E) Statistical Programming
- BWL-MA-BA 5(E) Choice-Based Optimization
- BWL-MA-BA 9(E) Deep Learning – An Introduction
- BWL-MA-OSCM 3(E) Advanced Topics in Operations Research

Free Elective Area

- Scope: 24 ECTS
- Elective modules have to be passed. Grades are not reported in your transcript.
- Modules from the Master of Science in Business Administration (except seminars)
- Language courses from the University Language Center (at least C1)
 - Except German in the General Track
 - Except English in the English Track
- Various courses offered by other faculties (such as WISO or MIN)
