Students acquire achievement points when they successfully fulfill the module or course requirements.

Calculated in accordance with regulations for the weighting of the final grade point average within the framework of exam regulations and, if applicable, in accordance with the supplementary departmental regulations; the current GPA is based on all achievements to date. After successful completion of studies, the Current GPA constitutes the final grade.
